In order to fulfil the requirement of the Sikhs, Guru Amar Das Ji established Manji System. He divided his spiritual realm in twenty two parts. Every part was called Manji. Guruji appointed an influential Sikh for every Manji. The duty of the Sikh was to preach the sermons of Guruji in his area. He received gifts from the Sikhs which were carried to Guruji. Because the Sikh delivered sermons while sittings on the Manji (cot) therefore it was called Manji system. With this system, the Sikh religion spread all over the country during the times of Guru Amar Das ji.
