STRUCTURE OF THEORY EXAM

General Guidelines

1. The question paper will cover the whole syllabus. No topic should be over-represented, and repetition of concepts should be avoided.
2. There are 3 sections in the question paper i.e. Section A, Section B and Section C.
3. 22 Questions are set in total. A student attempts 20 questions in all.

SECTION A (OBJECTIVE TYPE)- 12 marks

1. **Question No. 1 to 12 will consist of 12 objective-type questions carrying 1 mark each.** All questions will be compulsory to attempt. The answer of each question should not exceed one sentence. **Question types may include:** Multiple-choice questions (MCQs), MCQs with rationale, Match the following, True/False, Fill in the blanks, Gap-fill diagrams, and Labeling questions.

SECTION B (SHORT ANSWER TYPE)- 18 marks

1. **Question No. 13 to 19 will consist of 7 short answer type questions carrying 3 marks each.** The student will attempt any 6 of the given 7 questions. **Question types may include:** Simple diagrams, flow charts or short case-based questions. Short answer type questions may have two or more parts to it.

SECTION C (LONG ANSWER TYPE)- 10 marks

1. **Question No. 20 to 22 will consist of 3 long answer type questions.** The student will attempt any 2 of the given 3 questions. **Question Types may include:** Case-based analysis or the creation of moderate to complex diagrams with labels.
